The AFM BioMed Summer School offers an introduction to Atomic Force Microscopy in Life Sciences and Medicine for PhD students, post-docs, young scientists and core facility technicians/engineers. Lectures in the morning are complemented by hands-on experiments in the afternoon.

There are about 20 places for students doing hands-on experiments. Participants are encouraged to send a CV and a motivation letter. AFM beginners are welcome.

The registration fee for the AFM Summer School is 950€ for academics (1300€ for industry) that includes the training divided into 5 different sessions (more than 20 hours of courses), hands-on experiments, lunches, refreshments, accommodation and social events.
